



INTERNATIONAL AYURVEDA CONGRESS 2025 – PUNE, INDIA

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER/POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- Submitted abstracts will undergo scrutiny by the Scientific Committee for selection/rejection as well as their suitability for oral or poster presentation.
- The decision made by the Scientific Committee will be final and will be conveyed to the authors by email.
- Authors whose abstracts are selected for oral presentation will be required to prepare a presentation (in PowerPoint or Canva format) of their paper in appropriate scientific format and upload the same on the conference website or, if size exceeds 2 MB, submit it to the organizers by email. The date for final paper submission will be conveyed in due time.
- Only one oral presentation per delegate will be permitted.
- The first three best papers will be awarded. Decision of the judges will be final.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission:

1. **Original Research (Pre-Clinical studies/Clinical Trials/Cross Sectional Studies/Case Control/Cohort studies):** structured abstract of 250 to 300 words (background, objectives, material and methods, results, conclusion). Authors should follow appropriate reporting guidelines (see <https://www.equator-network.org/reporting-guidelines/>) while preparing their paper for oral presentation.
2. **General Topic/Reviews:** non-structured abstract of 250 to 300 words. Paper to be in IMRaD (Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion) format for presentation.
3. **Case Reports:** non-structured abstract of 250 to 300 words. Case should be unique with reference to diagnosis and treatment by Ayurveda. Authors should follow [CARE checklist](#) while preparing paper for oral presentation.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Delegates who will be participating in Poster Presentation are required to abide by the following guidelines:

- Recommended Poster Size is 3 ft or 0.9 m (width) times 4 ft or 1.2 meters (high) in FLEX form and should be clearly readable from five feet.
- Images in the poster should be of high definition/good clarity.
- The poster shall be carried by the presenter.
- Only one poster per presenter will be allowed.
- First three best posters will be awarded.
- Decision of the judges will be final.
