



Highlights of Nepal Pilgrimage

(Lumbini and Valmiki Ashram)

Trip features

Total Duration: 3 nights/4 days
Tour Grading: Easy to Moderate

Best season: All round the year except June to August

Tour starts/ends: Kathmandu

Accommodation: Tourist standard hotel

Trip highlights:

- Lumbini, the birth place of Lord Buddha
- Valmiki Ashram, the birth place of Lov-Kush and the origin of Valmiki Ramayana
- Gajendra Mokshya Dham and Triveni Samgam



Outline itinerary:

Day 01 (6 March 2023): Fly to Bhairahawa and drive to Lumbini and explore around

Fly to Bhairahawa and drive to Lumbini. After Lunch, we will visit some of the important Monasteries at the international monastic zone, Maya Devi temple, Pushkarini Lake and Ashok Pillar at the Sacred Garden, the birth place of Buddha Shakyamuni, explore around and meditate. Visit world peace pagoda. Overnight in the hotel.

Day 02 (7 March 2023): Drive to Triveni to visit Valmiki Ashram, back to Lumbini

Ascend 328m, total drive 180km, boat ride in the Narayani River to view Triveni sangam After having breakfast, we will drive to Triveni Dham at the bank of Narayani River at Susta. Visit Valmiki ashram, where Valmiki Ramayana was written and Lova-Kush were born/grown up. Visit Gajendra Moksha Dham and Triveni Ghat, the confluence of Narayani, Swarna and Tamra Bhadra rivers. Drive back to Bhairahawa.

Day 03 (8 March 2023): Fly to Kathmandu, guides sightseeing

After breakfast, fly to Kathmandu, Guided sightseeing in Patan, the city of fine arts and Bauddhanath, the biggest stupa and Tibetan center.

Day 04 (9 March 2023): Departure

Lumbini is not only the Birthplace of Lord Buddha, but one of the major attractions of Nepal for domestic and foreign visitors. Serenity and tranquility of Lumbini attracts thousands of visitors from different parts of the globe. Sacred Garden, Ashoka Pillar, Mayadevi Temple, Nativity Marker Stone, Perpetual Eternal Flame, World Peace Pagoda and important monasteries built by government of various countries are major attractions of the Lumbini. In addition to the Buddhist monasteries and monuments, farmlands of Lumbini are important habitat for many globally threatened birds of Nepal including Sarus Cranes. The day tour to Lumbini begins and ends in Kathmandu.
